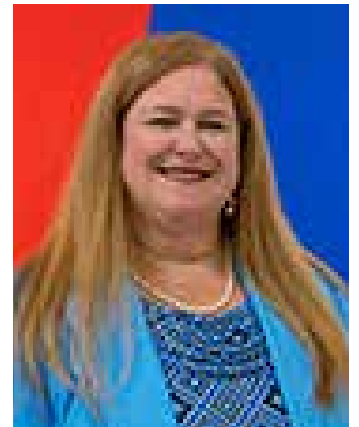

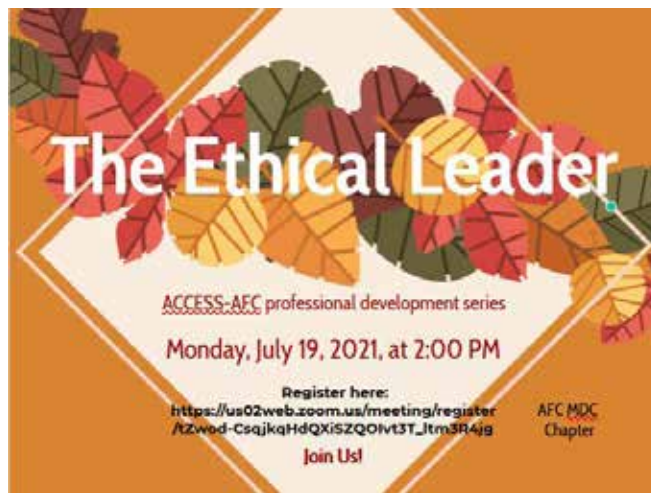

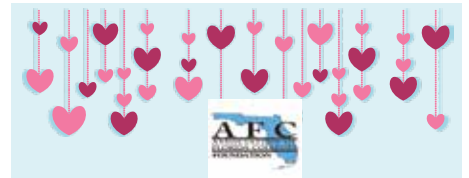

Labor Day/Día del Trabajo

The first Monday in September, United States celebrates Labor Day, to recognize the workforce contribution to the development and achievements of USA. The celebration was first proposed in the early 1880s, by labor movements and trade unions, and it was first celebrated with a public parade in New York on September 5th, 1892, under the auspices of the Knights of Labor and the Central Labor Union of N.Y. and became an official federal holiday in 1894. Numerous events are organized across the country every year. In Washington, D.C. a free concert is presented, featuring the National Symphony Orchestra.
