After touring the food pantry/business closet located in the new Access Department Area (4102) and continuing to set up and talk about future plans for both, the meeting began.

Food Pantry (**Fundraising Committee**) – It was suggested that we do department competitions to get employees to bring in canned or non-perishable goods for the food pantry. The winning department would win a pizza lunch.
